No vendors of volunteers are allowed to sell or distribute edible items. ○ Bags, water bags and bottles are not permissible while visiting the Science Centre. ○ Maintain silence during the visit, prolong use of mobile is prohibited and assure your mobile is on the silent mode. Spitting and smoking is strictly prohibited. If any visitor is found carrying pan-gutkha or caught spitting, he/ she will be charged a fine as per the rules and regulation. ○ Photography/ Videography is not allowed except with an authorised permission. ○ Uses suggestion box for any kind of complaints/ suggestions. Visitors are requested to behave properly with the staff and gallery attendants. Complaints or suggestions can be written in the complaint book. ○ Do not misbehave or argue with the security staff on duty. ○ Entry with the pet(s) is not allowed. ○ After taking ticket(s) visitors need to carry it during and till the end of Science Centre visit. ○ The time schedule of Science Centre will be according to the orders of Municipal Commissioner/ Science Centre authority. ○ Ticket(s) once sold will not be taken back and no cash refund will be given. ○ In case of any accidental circumstances if the Science Centre is to close, visitors will be allowed to enter with the same ticket once the Centre re-opens. ○ In the case of some natural calamity or emergency if the Science Centre has to close down, the final authority to give full cash refund or charge of date on ticket will be of municipal commissioner or authorised officer. ○ If visitor(s) cause damage to Science Centre property or any exhibit he/ she will be charged fine decided by Municipal Commissioner or authorised officer. It may subject to the Police procedure, if necessary. ○ In the case of any accident occurred in the
