GST (Goods and service tax has come in existence from 1st July, 2017. Contractor / Successful Bidder is bound to pay any amount of GST prescribed by the govt. of India as per the terms of the contract agreed upon during the course of execution of this contract. During the course of the execution of the contract, if there is any change in the GST (Goods and Services Tax) rate by the Government, the same shall be reimbursed/recovered separately by SMC. subject to the submission of original receipt/proof for the amounts actually remitted by the contractor/ successful Tenderer to the competent Authority along with a certificate from a Chartered Accountant of the contractor/ successful Tenderer certifying that the amount of GST paid to the government and the same shall be intimated/submitted/claimed within 30 (Thirty) days from the date of payment. Remittance of GST within the stipulated period shall be the sole responsibility of the successful contractor/Tenderer, failing which SMC may recover the amount due from any other payable dues with SMC, and the decision of the Municipal Commissioner shall be final and binding on the contractor/ successful Tenderer in this regard. Further, the non-payment of GST to the government may lead to the termination of the contract and forfeiture of the security Deposit/Performance Guarantee Amount. If imposition of any other new taxes/Duties/levies/Cess or any other incidentals etc. or any increase in the existing taxes/Duties/Levies/Cess or any other incidentals etc. (Excluding GST) are imposed during the course of the contract, the same shall be borne by the successful contractor/Tenderer only, in no case SMC shall be liable for the same.

**Terms and conditions:**

1	Once a quotation is offered, it shall not be withdrawn except with the permission of the competent authority of Surat Municipal Corporation.
2	The quotation, once accepted, will be binding on the contractor.
3	The rate should include all transportation, material, and labour costs.
4	The rates specified in BOQ/SCHEDULE-B by the contractor do not include GST. GST will be reimbursed separately (if applicable, based on the opinion of the SMC Account Department or the SMC GST Consultant) at the prevailing government-announced GST rates. The contractor shall be responsible for any changes in GST rates during the work. Payment (if applicable) for GST will be released only after the applicable amount appears on the government portal. The SMC Account Department's decision on the applicable GST rates will be final.
5	The competent authority of Surat Municipal Corporation reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without providing any reason.
6	The Deputy Municipal Commissioner's decision will be final regarding any dispute that arises.
7	Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 5000/- in the form of a demand draft or pay order only should be remitted along with the quotation. It must be issued by any nationalised or scheduled bank in favour of the Commissioner, S.M.C., and payable at Surat.
8	In the absence of EMD, the quotations will be liable to be rejected.
9	The Contractor shall not raise any dispute if the quantity of work is actually reduced or increased at the time of work.
10	The contract shall be governed by and subject to the laws of India and the state of Gujarat, and shall be under the jurisdiction of the courts in Surat, Gujarat only.
11	The time limit for the work is 180 days from the work order's issue date. If the contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated completion date, he shall pay liquidated damages of 0.20% of the contract value per day of delay, or part thereof, as the case may be; however, this shall be subject to a maximum of ten (10) per cent of the contract value.
12	The successful Bidder/Tenderer will be required to provide a performance bond (Security Deposit) amounting to two per cent (2%) of the total cost.
13	The defect liability period shall last for one year from the date of Completion of the work.
14	The quotation should invariably be superscripted with the name of the work and the department (e.g., Storm Drainage, New East (Sarothana) Zone, S.M.C.).
15	Quotation should invariably be submitted to the office of the New East (Sarothana) Zone, Vahivati Bhavan, Beside Sankalp Residency, Behind Shyamdham Temple Cross Roads, Sarothana, Surat, before dt: -20/03/2026.

**Scope of Work: -**

**Detailed Scope of work for repairing of sluice gates: -**

1	Dismantling, repairing, maintaining, re-erecting, and commissioning sluice gates.
2	Replacement of consumable materials such as gaskets, rubber packing, graphite packing, grease, etc., is within the scope of the contractor.
3	Repair of Hed stok within the scope of the contractor.
4	Any missing nut or bolt within the contractor's scope.
5	All cutting and welding required as per site specifications within the contractor's scope.
6	The thoroughness of stems, if needed, will be within the contractor's scope.
7	Thoroughly clean the gate assembly. Remove all foreign matter, paint, sand, concrete droppings, debris, and so on. This includes the seat facing, wedging and sliding surfaces, gate guides, wedge blocks, the bottom sill of the gate, and the invert. Take every possible care to ensure the smooth operation of the gates.
8	All necessary arrangements for lifting, transportation, and tools/tackles within the Contractor's scope.
9	Water diversion falls under the contractor's scope.
10	Conbextra GP2 grouting is within the scope of the contractor.
11	All miscellaneous items, such as vehicles, tools, testing equipment, cleaning or housekeeping materials/ equipment, safety gear, electrical equipment, etc., shall be supplied by the contractor at their own cost. All other items and labour, including major and minor spares, repairs, and replacements, shall fall within the contractor's scope.

**SAFETY REGULATIONS**

1	Work will be performed according to best engineering practices and safety standards, in line with industry, national, and international standards.
2	All safety precautions, necessary arrangements, colour code, notice board, etc., as per the Govt. safety rules.
3	A first aid kit must be kept ready at the work site.
4	Contractor shall arrange personal protective equipment for his employees in accordance with the Site conditions.
5	The contractor shall ensure the safety of the work and personnel and shall be entirely responsible for any damage or injury to property or persons resulting from any accident, for any reason.
6	The Corporation shall not be responsible for any death/accident/injury to the workman/staff of the Contractor or third party. It is the contractor's responsibility to ensure insurance coverage for his employees, medical facilities, workmen's compensation, etc., in accordance with the Workmen's Compensation Act and all other relevant laws. Further, the corporation will not provide any insurance / medical facilities, workman's compensation, etc., to the contractor's staff.
7	All personnel employed by the contractor for the work should be fully insured against any accidents or injuries.
8	The Contractor must exercise sufficient care when moving, handling, and installing equipment to avoid causing injury or damage to persons or property of the SMC or other workers in or around the work site. If any injury or damage occurs, the expenses, including the SMC's estimated loss of work hours, shall be borne by the Contractor.
9	No accommodation, guest house, or transportation facility will be provided by the corporation to the contractor.
