Passing criteria for university examination as per NMC—

- 1. In subjects that have two papers, must secure minimum 40% of marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass in the said subject.
- 2. Shall obtain 50% marks in aggregate & 60:40(minimum) or 40:60 (minimum) in university conducted examination separately in theory & in practical (practical includes—practical / clinical/viva) in order to be declared as passed in that subject.
- 3. There shall be no grace marks for passing in university examination.
- 4. If any student fails in university examination, he will appear in supplementary examination. Supplementary examinations and declaration of results shall be processed within 3-6 weeks from the date of declaration of the results of the main examination for every professional year, so that the candidates, who pass, can join the main batch for progression.
- 5. If the candidate fails in the supplementary examination of first MBBS, he shall join the batch of next academic /subsequent year. There shall be no supplementary batches. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt.
- 6. A candidate, who fails in the First Professional examination, shall not be allowed to join Second Professional.
