Please refer your application dated 31.05.2021 and followed by reminder letter dated 20.11.2021for increase of 50 MBBS seats at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Suratunder the Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Suratu/s 26(1)(b)(c) & (d), 28(1)(2)(3) & 29 and section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2021-22. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board of National Medical Commission vide its letter no. NMC/UGI/2020/000123/035027 dated 05.11.2021 has disapproved your application for increase of seats from 200 to 250 due to deficiencies communicated to you.

The college has been granted additional 50 students under EWS Quota vide Ministry of Health and Family Welfare's letter no. U12012/350/2019-ME.1dated 19.07.2019 (increase of seats 50 MBBS i.e. 150 to 200 under EWS Quota). The college was originally recognized for 150 MBBS seats with the letter of continuation of recognition with reference BOG letter no. MCI-34(41)(UG)/2018-Med./191138 dated 17.02.2020.

On review of the records, since the college is already having 200 MBBS seats (150 regular + 50 EWS) with mandatory quota of EWS scheme, the MARB of NMC has re-considered the proposal and decided to increase of seats from 200 to 250 as a regular permission. Thus will have 250 MBBS seats (i.e. 200 regular seats + 50 EWS seats during the AY 2022-23).

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) of NMC pleased to inform that;

APPROVED FOR INCREASE OF 50 MBBS SEATS (200 to 250 MBBS SEATS)

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In view of the above, approval of 200 to 250 MBBS seats, the Commission has decided to obtain undertaking/essential documents for issue of Letter of Permission for starting/increase in seats for the academic year 2022-23:

- 1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, building, equipment and hospital facilities as per National Medical Commission norms.
- 2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal Letter of Permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB).
- 3. The Private Medical College should provide Bank Guarantee against Increase of new MBBS seats at your medical colleges with intake of number of MBBS seats (50) in favour of National Medical Commission, New Delhi valid for 05 years or till the course is recognised, whichever is later, from a nationalized/scheduled Bank in accordance with NMC norms. However, medical college/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- 4. The Medical Colleges/ Institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend during the Internship of the UG students similar to UG sections of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
- 5. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Intent/Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentative of facts or fraud.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regards issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be constructed that the admission in the college were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

Action to grant formal permission of the Medical assessment & Rating Board (MARB) for increased intake/starting of the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above.

The acceptance letter may be sent immediately to enable the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) to issue Letter of Permission for the academic year 2022-23.
